## EU JOINT PROGRAMMING

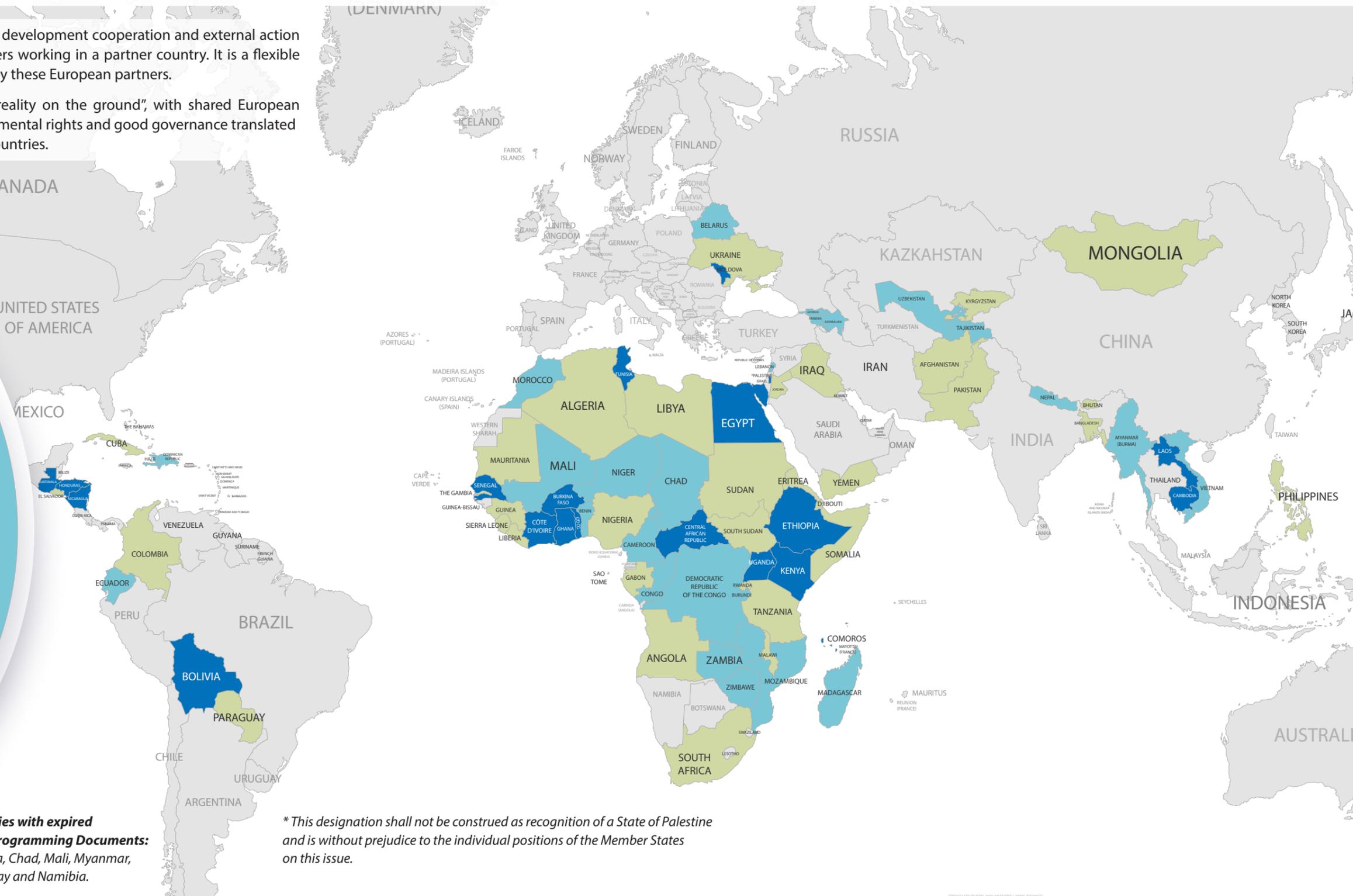
Joint Programming is the joint planning of development cooperation and external action by EU development/external action partners working in a partner country. It is a flexible and tailored process designed and driven by these European partners.
