Weak policy/regulatory framework & lack of awareness

New perspectives

- clean and more efficient solutions

Main findings

- Huge financial gaps & sustainability
 - costly small-scale individual investments
 - beneficiaries' low capacity-to-pay for upfront and fuel costs
 - low local finance mobilisation



Sustainable Energy Annual Action Plan new priorities for clean cooking

- Shift to market approach/Support the private sector's development
- Give priority to urban areas and high tiers where possible (without excluding other options)
- Adapt the solutions to the context (institutional/houselholds, policy framework, etc.)

- Are aligned with the Sustainable Energy Investment (SEI) platform's recommendations
- Are complementary to EU Delegations' actions
