We stand before an ambitious agenda of change. Achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), moving to the 1.5°C climate target and saving millions of species from extinction — while reaching those excluded from economic growth — requires addressing root causes of unsustainable development and a transformation to a decarbonized (or low-carbon) economy; an economy in which the growth of jobs, income and prosperity is driven by policies and investments in solutions for global sustainability challenges.

PAGE brings together the specialized expertise of five United Nations agencies and aims to accelerate a sustainability revolution. The partnership offers a comprehensive, coordinated and cost-effective package of:

- Economic and scientific analytical tools;
- Technical assistance for policy development, and;
- Capacity building services for policy implementation.

PAGE has emerged as an innovative model of inter-agency cooperation for other UN initiatives that seek to deliver as one.

A just transition to an SDGs-aligned economy – one that is low-carbon, nature-friendly, resource efficient and socially inclusive, especially for gender and youth – requires:

- Long-term planning.
- Balanced and integrated macroeconomic policies.
- Efficiency and coordination in policymaking and execution.
- Distributional considerations in policy actions.
- Global leadership and coordination.

PAGE in the Policy Cycle

PAGE provides demand-driven, technical assistance and capacitybuilding support to countries for:

- Macroeconomic and sectoral policymaking;
- Designing and implementing green jobs and green enterprise policies;
- Social inclusion and poverty reduction;
- Green industry and SMEs;
- Financing a green economy transition; and
- Green economy learning.

Areas of Action


The focus areas of action for PAGE remain upstream, where policies that shape the full economy are created and propelled downstream.

Guiding Principles for PAGE Country Engagement

COUNTRY OWNERSHIP

All processes are driven by key ministries, in cooperation with national stakeholders, and are supported by PAGE.

PROGRAMMATIC AND POLICY FOCUS

Specialized technical assistance is provided on strategic policy analysis and macroeconomic, sectoral and thematic policy development.

LINKAGES WITH NATIONAL **DEVELOPMENT PLANNING**

PAGE support is connected with the existing structures and processes for long-term sustainability.

MULTI-MINISTERIAL ENGAGEMENT

Activities are initiated in countries where key ministries have jointly expressed interest in collaborating with PAGE.

MULTI-STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT

Key stakeholder groups and societal partners are engaged in the planning and delivery of PAGE services.

JOINT COMMITMENT **FOR RESULTS**

Governments and PAGE partners work together based on a collective commitment to achieve sustainable growth for all.

PAGE Partner Country

PAGE partner countries receive technical and policy support for a transition toward an inclusive green economy. The key selection criteria for prospective partner countries include:

- Demonstrated support and commitment of key ministries for IGE.
- A clear demand for technical assistance.
- Linkages between requested support and national planning processes.
- Regional balance and inclusion of both larger and smaller economies.

PAGE Funding Partner

PAGE funding partners contribute to the PAGE Trust Fund and:

- Provide overall strategic guidance.
- Advise in the selection of new PAGE countries.
- Review annual progress reports and suggest corrective actions.
- Ensure that independent evaluations are carried out and recommendations are addressed.
