- **Ad hoc support:** Support to develop a proposal for a supra municipal result-oriented investment model in Colombia

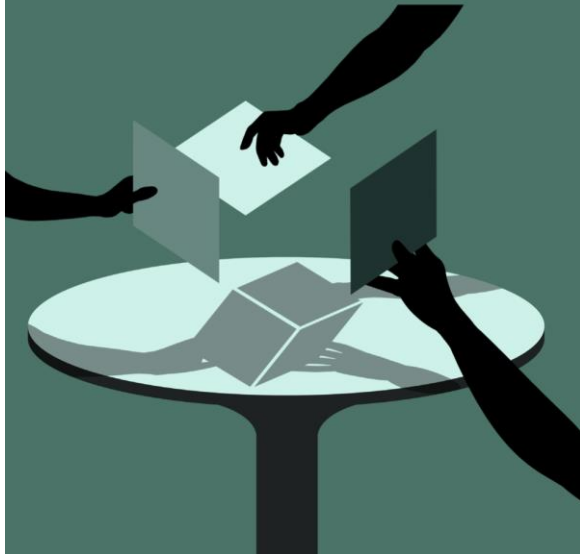
