European Commission	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The work for the Mid Term Review (MTR) contributing to drafting the next MIP (Multi Annual Indicative Programme, = strategy) and MAAP (Multi Annual Action Programme = detailed description how funds are going to be used) for the period 2018-2020 in parallel to a new budgetary outlook for the period 2018-2020 has commenced. We have signed a grant agreement with Council of Europe, implementation by North-South Centre for a project with the title iLEGEND, Intercultural Learning Exchange through Global Education, Networking and Dialogue, Budget: 1,333 Million EURO, 75% financed by COM, 25% by CoE. Duration: July 2016-July 2019, Purpose: The overall objective is to strengthen global/development education in EU Member States and potential Member States, particularly where it is least established by promoting dialogue, networking strategies, capacity building and exchange of good education practices in the field of global/development education. The first regional seminar of this cycle will take place in Tallinn, Estonia, next 24-25 October.</p> <p>Capacity-Building: six annual e-learning courses per year covering the HR, Intercultural Dialogue and Democratic citizenship dimensions of GE; 2 annual residential courses for youth multipliers on Youth and Global Citizenship; updating of the Global Education Guidelines.</p> <p>Networking and awareness-raising: through the Global Education Week network dissemination of GE practice and sharing of expertise and coordination of the Global Education Week (3rd week of November).</p>
