EL PACCTO - Europe Latin America Programme of Assistance against Transnational Organised Crime

- Regional program that supports the fight against organised crime through the promotion of technical cooperation between European and Latin American public institutions
- It is a demand-oriented program and works with the support of focal points within partner regional and national institutions of 17 countries
- Co-Delegation Agreement between **FIIAPP** (Spain) and **EF** (France) and involves **CIVIPOL** (France), **IILA** (Italy) and **Camões** (Portugal)
 1. **Police** Component: CIVIPOL through a grant contract with EF
 2. **Justice** Component: FIIAPP
 3. **Penitentiary** Component: IILA through a service contract with FIIAPP
 4. **Cross-Cutting** Component: FIIAPP and EF
- It began in **2017** and its first phase will conclude in **mid-2023**

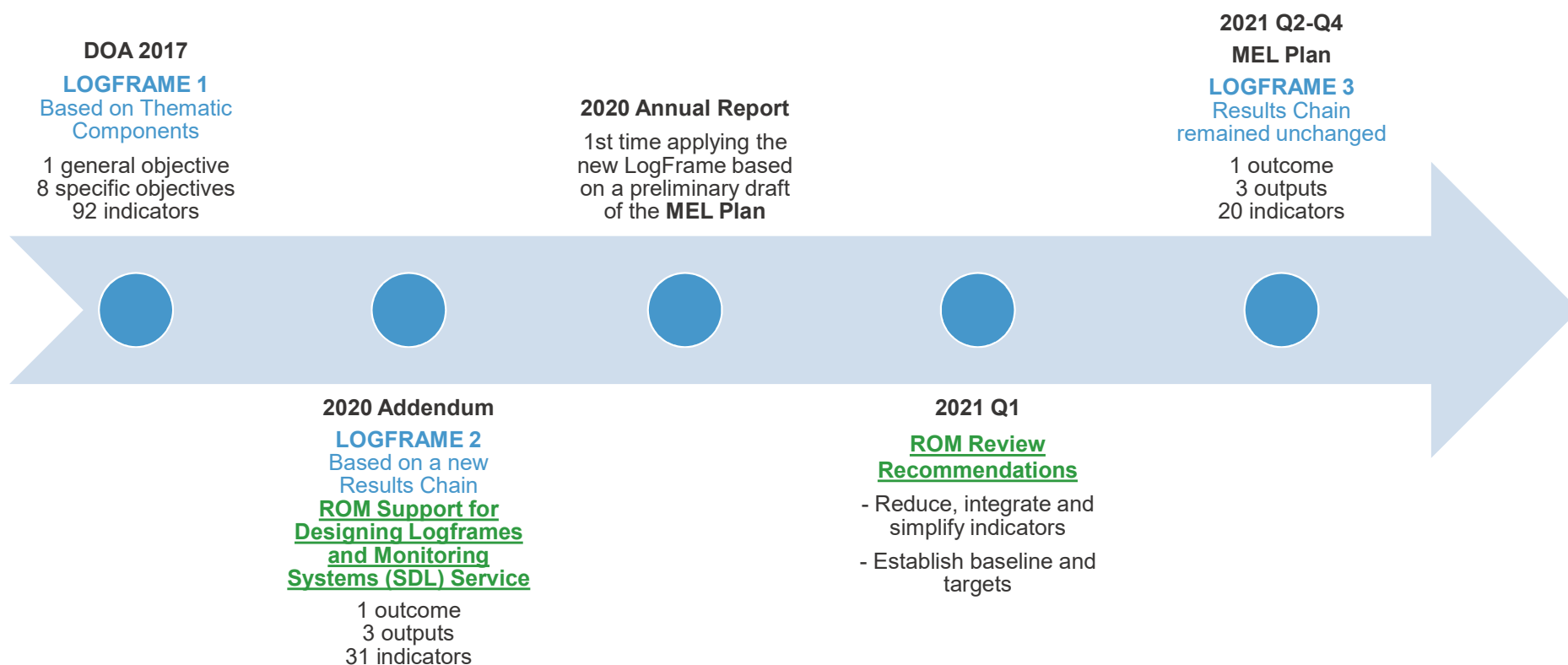

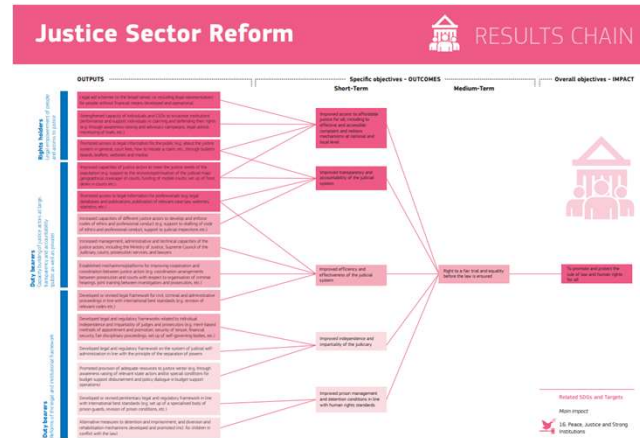


EVOLUTION OF EL PACCTO'S LOGICAL FRAMEWORK



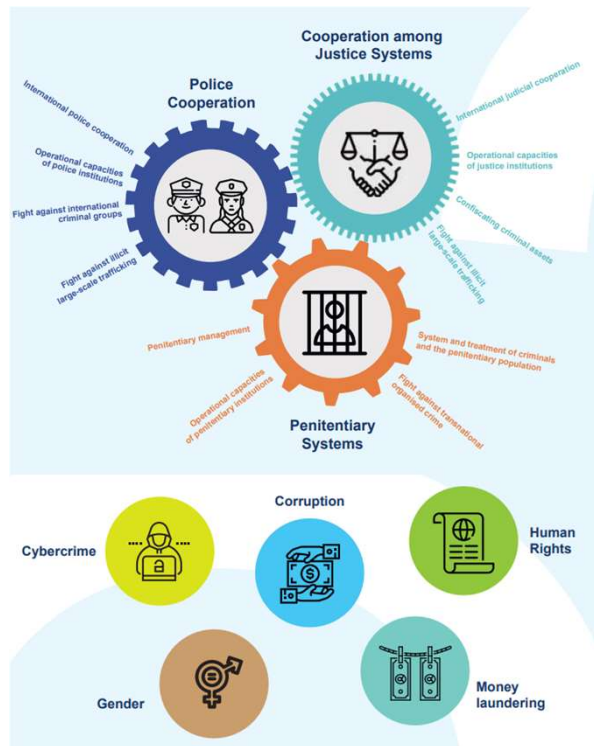
RESULT CHAIN UPDATE PROCESS

1. Analysis of the **guidance on thematic results** for the sectors of justice and security of **Capacity4Dev** sent by OM and the D4 Unit (January 2020)
2. Analysis of the **Result Chain of the DoA** to identify possible result groupings throughout thematic components and lines of action (January 2020)
3. Orientations and recommendations from **ROM consultants** on the design of a new result chain (February 2020)
4. Presentation of the new proposed results chain to **key members of EL PACCTO's Team** (March 2020)
5. Presentation of the revised **new proposed result chain to INTPA** (March 2020)
6. EL PACCTO's Addendum was **approved** with the new proposed result chain (April 2020).

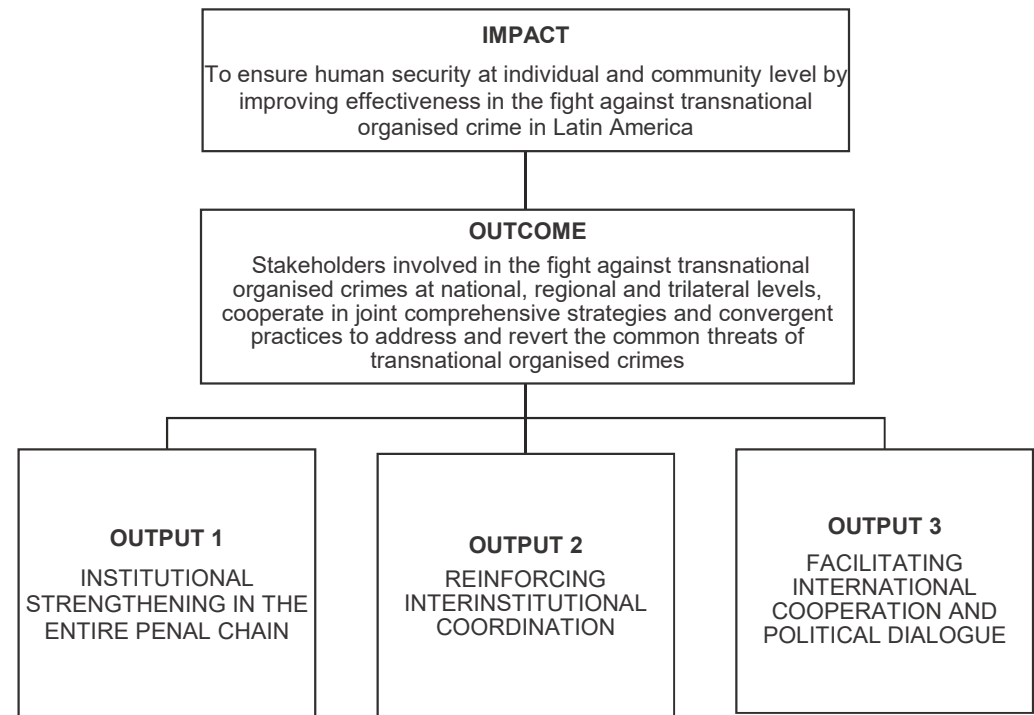

LOGICAL FRAMEWORK INDICATORS UPDATE PROCESS

1. Analysis of **ROM Review** recommendations (March to April 2021)
2. Review of **SDG and EU RF frameworks** and other internal and external resources such as the **guidance on indicators from Capacity4Dev**, the EU Action Plan on Women, Peace and Security 2019-2024, and others (May 2021)
3. Analysis and **integration of the previous version of the LF indicators** into new indicators (May 2021)
4. First proposal presented to **EL PACCTO's Directors, Administrators and M&E POCs + FIIAPP's KM Unit and EF's M&E Division** (June 2021)
5. Second proposal presented to the **EL PACCTO's Team** in a participative workshop (July 2021)
6. Third proposal shared and discussed with other **EU Programs** – including: EL PACCTO supports AMERIPOL, INTERPOL supports EL PACCTO, EUROsociAL+, I-CRIME, EUROCLIMA, COPOLAD III, SOCIEUX (July to September 2021)
7. Fourth proposal sent to **INTPA** for review and discussed with members of the **D4 Unit** in Brussels (September 2021)
8. Final proposal **approved by INTPA** (December 2021)



CHALLENGES AND BENEFITS

CHALLENGES

- Balancing each implementing institution's priorities, information needs and requirements regarding M&E
- Adapting internal processes to guarantee the adoption of the new Results Chain and indicators
- Building internal capacities and guaranteeing resources to implement the new Logical Framework and MEL Plan within the team

BENEFITS

- Improved coordination and alignment with other EU programs and amongst implementing partner institutions
- Better explicit formulation of the logic of the intervention and enhanced integration amongst thematic components
- Increased result-orientation in the planning (i.e. targets) and monitoring
- Improved ability to communicate the progress of the program in a more comprehensive and integrated manner
- Enhanced capacity to make data-driven decisions that promote program learning and continuous improvement
