Why knowledge management for Climate Change?


Mainstreaming CC

- Making the transition from a science to a policy issue
- Supporting CC institutions (i.e. may be relatively new and deal with strong coordination mandate)
- Adaptation needs to be integrated into government planning systems

Preparing future action

- Expanding outreach
- Addressing knowledge gaps
- Highlighting development opportunities (not only costs and difficulties)
- Partnership and communication are critical

Using knowledge: expertise from stakeholders and governments

Example: Approach for Impacts and Adaptation



Informed by: Assessments (IPCC, ACIA, National)
Enabled by: National Climate Change Adaptation Framework

Generating informed decision-making

Knowledge

- Current and future climate vulnerabilities
- Current and future adaptive capacity
- Timing and rate of climate changes

Engagement

- Engagement of key opinion leaders and planning communities
- Improved interaction between science and decision-making community

Tools

- Appropriate risk assessment methodologies
- Appropriate risk managing tools appropriate for users
- Costing of impacts and adaptation options
- Processes to integrate CC into existing planning systems (mainstreaming)
- Maintain the functionality of the tools





Overall KM Approach


- Focus on KM cycle

- Facilitate and foster policy dialogue, and technical and financial support to regional and national partners
- Focus on three priority areas of the GCCA+
- KM demand-led (listen to stakeholders)
- KM Strategy is the strategic guidance for the KM operational and action plan.

Priority KM activities in GCCA+

GCCA+ Pillar 1. Support platform for dialogue and exchange of experiences

1. **Knowledge sharing** - Collect, share and make available 'solutions' (success stories, Lessons learned and good practices) on climate change adaptation and mitigation resulting from GCCA+ interventions
2. **Networking** - Facilitate online interaction between stakeholders linked with the existing face-to-face global and regional events and meetings
3. **Learning** – Provide access to learning materials to GCCA+ priority areas for policy events, meetings and workshops
4. **Information sharing** - Provide access to expertise on climate change policy development at regional and national level



Priority KM activities in GCCA+

GCCA+ Pillar 2. Technical and financial Support to GCCA interventions

1. **Project Management** - Collect, map and make available GCCA+ project information and results to GCCA+ stakeholders
2. **Project Management / M&E** – Facilitate monitoring of project progress (PM) (Result Dashboard)
3. **Learning/ Knowledge sharing** – Provide access to guidelines, courses and training activities on PPCM and RBM
4. **Learning/Information sharing** – Provide access to information on GCCA+ priority areas and guidance on project identification



Priority KM activities in GCCA+

GCCA+ Pillar 3. Communication and KM in place to support stakeholders

1. **Knowledge Management** - Establish a governance and support structure to guide and support Knowledge Management
2. **Communication/Visibility**– Support showcasing success stories of knowledge sharing and collaboration/networking of stakeholders at all levels to highlight GCCA+ innovative approach
3. **Communication/Knowledge sharing** - Provide evidence on results and success stories of GCCA+ projects
4. **Networking** – Support interaction on GCCA+ priority research topics and needs of research institutions in GCCA+ targeted countries






