Joint United Nations-European Parliament meeting:

Accelerating Action to Reduce Climate-Related Disasters - The Road to COP27

Following the release of the recent IPCC Working Group II Report, it is clear that we are not on the right track to address the climate emergency with the level of urgency needed. The report finds that around 3.3 - 3.6 billion people, or around 40% of the world's population, are highly vulnerable to the impacts of climate change. We need to prepare for a world warmer than 1.5° - a world characterized by an exponential increase in magnitude, intensity and frequency of extreme events fuelled by climate change.

How can we prepare for a more climate-extreme world, while building a resilient society leaving no-one behind?
