
EU strategy to boost sustainable links around the world

The background of a complex global landscape

- COVID-19 pandemic and the impact of today's incomplete or disconnected global infrastructure
- Lack of digital connections, the disruption to supply chains and the scarcity of medical goods
- Global infrastructure investment deficit €13 trillion by 2040
- How to ensure that global connections and networks develop in line with democratic values and high standards?



Global Gateway & Team Europe Initiatives

- In one sentence, Global Gateway captures what the EU stands for as partner and is delivered through Team Europe and mainly through TEIs.
- 155 TEIs so far are moving to next steps of design and implementation:
 - 134 TEIs in INTPA countries/regions
 - 18 TEIs in NEAR countries/regions
 - 3 thematic global TEIs (democracy, sustainability in global supply chains, Green Bonds)

Global Gateway & Team Europe Initiatives

- First deliverables:
- February 2022
 - ➤ AU-EU Summit Global gateway Africa-Europe Investment Package
 - ➤ Indo-Pacific Ministerial forum

Agreement on the need to accelerate the work on continental/regional/multi-country flagships taking the form of Team Europe Initiatives that directly support the roll out of Global Gateway

Beyond these flagships, Global Gateway will be delivered through a multitude of flagships at national level, which are by definition wherever possible Team Europe Initiatives.





TEI examples

Developing Chile's Green Hydrogen (GH2) - Chile

What:

Fostering green hydrogen production and export in Chile by strengthening the enabling environment, supporting Technological Development and Human Capital, Market Development/Business Cooperation, and Project Development/Finance











Who:

AT, BE, DE, DK, ES, FI, FR, IE, NL, PT, SE, KfW, EIB



TEI examples

Job creation through Trade and Investment in - Southern Neighbourhood

What:

Foster decent job creation through increased levels of trade and investments, and contribute to an inclusive economic recovery through improved skills and entrepreneurship in the Southern Neighbourhood region.













Who:

SW, ES, DE, FR, IT, AFD, KFW, EIB, EBRD





How to get involved?

- Team Europe Initiatives get support both from the EU budget and are therefore guided by NDICI programming guidelines-, and of the EU Member States and DFIs.
- Team Europe Initiatives draw on the best mix of funding/support modalities, tools and partners and the wealth of the collective experience, expertise and resources.
- In short: you can get involved as an implementer or contributor.



How to get involved as implementer?

- Global Gateway and TEIs will be implemented through all kinds of modalities and all TE partners
- For the EU:
 - EFSD+ guarantees and blending
 - Procurement
 - Grants
 - Indirect Management
 - TAIEX/Twinning





Conclusions – Global Gateway...

- ...an EU plan post-COVID & post-COP26 for major investment in infrastructure development around the world
- ...will be under the overall steer of President von der Leyen
- ...projects will be developed through Team Europe Initiatives, consistent with the SDGs
