

# EU GENDER ACTION PLAN III

## Country Level Implementation Plan for **Thailand** (2021–2025)

GENDER ACTION PLAN (GAP) III is the European Union's blueprint for building a gender-equal world aiming to curb the rise of inequalities, and to accelerate progress on gender equality and women's empowerment. GAP III emphasises the importance of working together with EU Member States, in close cooperation with all partners, including civil society and communities to enhance the involvement of women's and youths' organisations and movements.

### Translating GAP III into action

#### The Country Level Implementation Plan (CLIP) for Thailand:

- Translates the EU Gender Action Plan III into actions for Thailand, using the 'Working Better Together' approach.
- Identifies priority areas, aligning with the country level programming.
- Was prepared and will be undertaken by Team Europe in Thailand.

### CLIP approaches

#### Key approaches for the implementation of the CLIP:

- Gender mainstreaming.
- Targeted actions supporting gender equality and women's empowerment.
- Dialogue with Ministries and engagement with civil society in Thailand.
- Public diplomacy campaigns.

### CLIP–Areas of Engagement

1. Challenge gender norms and power inequalities;
2. Gender based violence, including targeting the LGBTI community;
3. Empowerment of women and advancing equal political participation and leadership;
4. Furthering the Women Peace and Security Agenda in Thailand;
5. Addressing the gender gap in the green and digital transitions (so that they can be just transitions).

### Rational for CLIP

#### The CLIP areas of engagement are based on:

- Gender Country Profile for Thailand.
- Dialogue with National Government and consultations with civil society organisations (CSOs).

### Actions foreseen under CLIP instruments

- Gender as a priority area in national calls for proposals funded by the EU in Thailand from 2021-2025, with a focus on gender equality and women's empowerment.
- Policy Dialogue and technical assistance with the Government of Thailand on gender aspects through the Thailand Cooperation Facility (for instance, on data collection for SDG 5 in Thailand; Women, Peace and Security issues).
- Dialogue and engagement with civil society in Thailand under the framework of the "CSO roadmap 2021-2025" to ensure gender mainstreaming in all areas.
- Capacity strengthening of civil society in Thailand to engage young people, particularly from marginalised groups, on gender equality.
- Capacity building of women's groups on bio-circular green economy and innovation.
- Capacity building on connectivity and digital literacy and skills.
- Public diplomacy activities (focused on key International Days) to raise awareness on gender equality issues.
