ClimAct (SPARK) is about gender justice, climate justice and development. It builds public support for ambitious climate change and development policies, with women's voices from across the globe at its heart. With ecofeminist lenses, SPARK identifies climate solutions that also fight gender inequalities. It builds understanding about the interconnectedness of climate change, gender equality and development issues.

FoodWave is creating alliances between institutions, civil society and young people for a green, inclusive and sustainable future of our cities. The project focuses on the importance of sustainable food systems at urban level and the adoption of responsible lifestyles and practices by young people between 15 to 35 years old to mitigate climate change. Through activism schools, discussion forums, street actions, community dinners, film festivals, workshops and more, the young activists are leading the change — starting with food.

I Am European (IAE) fosters public debate and increased media coverage of migration, refugee and diversity issues that are nuanced and evidence-based. Focusing on young people, media training, school simulations, virtual reality experiences and speaker tours help build empathy and inclusion in eight EU Member States. At the heart of the social media campaigns are real people with real experiences and stories of migration.

People & Planet mobilises young citizens and (g)local authorities for sustainable development goals (SDGs). It equips future change-makers with digital tools to raise “planet awareness”. Its coalition of Local Authorities (LAs) enhances their visibility and ability to promote sustainable behaviours. In Cape Verde and in eight EU Member States, People and Planet uses creative multimedia tools, participatory and dynamic methodologies for nonformal education.

1Planet4All brings together NGOs across Europe to draw attention to the impact of climate change on the Global South. Focusing on young people, it develops a sense of shared responsibility to take action against “climate injustice”. It supports teachers and media to communicate about the complex issues around climate change. It organises young journalist visits and highlights stories from communities directly affected by climate change. It offers resources for global citizenship educators and supports student, football and art associations to act on climate change.

#ClimateOfChange is a pan-European campaign around the connections between Migration and Climate Change. The project engages young people in Europe to support policies and actions to tackle climate change as a driver of forced displacement. #ClimateOfChange develops critical understanding of climate change-induced migration as one of the biggest challenges of today's interdependent world.
