This joint side event will take place virtually on Tuesday November 9th, 2021, at 18:30 CET (17:30 Glasgow time) for one hour.

The event **high level panel** will present concrete examples of support by the Intra-ACP GCCA+ and ClimSA programmes and the added value of the OACPS-EU partnership. A youth Pacific leader will also participate to the event providing first hand experiences and insights from the most vulnerable countries to climate change. Representatives from the Negotiation Groups of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), OACPS Regions, partners, non-state actors and the public at large will be invited to join the discussion.
