The Alliance for a changing world (2007–2022)

This final publication gives an overview of the Global Climate Change Alliance Plus (GCCA+) a flagship initiative of the European Union giving an overview of 15 years of climate change cooperation over four continents, with lessons learned that can be useful to define and deliver tailored, practical actions that build resilience and encourage mitigation actions. They can help future actions in meaningfully designing, implementing and communicating climate response.

Results 2007-2022

This publication gives an overview of the main results and outputs Global Climate Change Alliance Plus (GCCA+) a flagship initiative of the European Union giving an overview of 15 years of climate change cooperation over four continents.

Guides on monitoring and evaluation of climate adaptation action

The Quick Guide is a fast read to improve the design and implemen-tation of actions that have climate change adaptation as a main or significant objective. An extended version, the "Practical Guide for Monitoring and Evaluation of adaptation action" illustrates in detail, with practical steps and examples, the key findings from the review of the 15 GCCA/GGCA+ national and regional projects.

Impact and Sustainability reports

The Impact and Sustainability Report (main report and 21 country reports) describes direct and indirect impacts achieved by 21 projects supported between 2009 and 2017 by the Global Climate Change Alliance Plus (EU GCCA+). It provides a comparison of actual and expected impacts, a description of the levels of sustainability as well as drivers of successes and failures in terms of impact and sustainability. A useful tool for managers and implementers it also contains recommendations for design and implementation of future projects.
