EW4All Executive Plan - Financing

- ❑ Balanced financing across the early warning value cycle
- ❑ Ensure financing for early action through people-centred, risk-informed approaches
- ❑ Incentivizing private sector actors to play a role
- ❑ Use pooled financing mechanism
 - ❑ Ensuring a coordinated approach, reducing duplication, fragmentation
 - ❑ Continuous learning and ‘agile’ development
 - ❑ Lowers risk and overheads

Early Warning Financing - Scale, Access, Coherence



- Sustaining basic observation networks through the **Systematic Observations Financing Facility (SOFF)**
- Bridging the capacity gap in LDCs and SIDS through the **Climate Risk and Early Warning System (CREWS)**



- Leveraging Development Partners and Climate Funds:
 - **World Bank, Regional Development Banks (RDBs)**
 - **Green Climate Fund (GCF), Adaptation Fund (AF)**
 - **Climate Investments Funds (CIFs)**




- **CREWS Accelerated Support Window** – fast, targeted financing for immediate technical assistance
- **GCF/CREWS Scaling-up Framework on Early Warning**, linked to the Simplified Approval Process (SAP)




Pacific SIDS regional project


