

Legend:



MIP Analysis of the Biodiversity (2021-2027)










18 Approved PIPs by Investment Window

Total Guarantee capacity (up to)






Approved PIPs for by DFI (9)

EUROCLIMA

EUROCLIMA update

- **Covers all Latin American and Caribbean countries**
- **EUROCLIMA Caribbean**
- **Budget:** EUR 70 M in current MFF (Previous MFF allocation was 144 M)
- **Implemented** by member state agencies (AECID, EF/AFD, FIIAPP, GIZ) and UNEP and ECLAC plus for the Caribbean: UNDP
- Inclusion of biodiversity (NBSAPs) as well as climate change (NDCs)
- How to engage with private sector? (working group)
- Annual meeting

Discussion questions

- How does this all make sense to me as a programme manager in an EU Delegation? What next?

 - The investment agenda & the EUDs submission to HQ
 - The approved PIPs
 - The blending
 - The IFIs
 - The traditional cooperation - bilateral programme priorities (where they exist)

 - The TEIs (global, regional and national)
