The TALD Facility: (2020-2023)

Four types of support to accompany EU actions in topics related to decentralization, local governance and territorial development:

Diagnosis and in-depth analyses:

- Integrated **Decentralization** Diagnostic Framework (**IDDF**)
- Integrated Territorial Development Diagnostic (ITDD, includes also urban and rural policies)



2. Policy Dialogue:

- High level Dialogue between EU (possible with Member States) and the **national government**
- Support for multi-level governance (National Sub national)
- Support for horizontal, multi-stakeholder, concertation (LAs, CSOs, private sector)
- > Structured Dialogue between EUDs and Associations of Local Authorities (Tool: "EU Roadmaps for Engagement with Local Authorities")



3. Support during programming process:

- ➤ **Identification/formulation** of relevant actions related to decentralization, local governance and local development to include in Annual Action Plans (AAP)
- ➤ Technical assistance to embed the Territorial Approach during the **implementation** of a program (throughout the project cycle)
- Support to include TALD and local authorities in Calls for Proposals for CSOs, alongside other key actors (private sector and academia)



4. Capacity building:

Global TALD Seminars:

For EUDs in all regions: Virtual seminar in July 2020 For staff at HQ, Brussels, July 2022

- > Regional TALD Seminars: For staff in EUDs
 - ➤ Latin America and the Caribbean: Cuba (Sept 2022)
 - > Africa (English-speaking): South Africa (Oct 2022)
 - Africa (French-speaking): Ivory Coast (Nov 2022)
 - Asia-Pacific: India (April 2023)
- TALD is a **Demand-Driven Facility** and can offer ad-hoc capacity building to EUDs
- ➤ It can support **Decentralized Cooperation** exchanges (in partnership with TAIEX)



TAIEX INTPA: Introduction





WHAT IS TAIEX?

- ✓ Demand-driven short-term assistance provided by EU MS public administrations to public administrations in INTPA partner countries
- ✓ Exchange ideas and strengthening capacities of the public administrations in implementation of national development plans and SDGs
- ✓ Sharing of EU MS best practice and peerto-peer knowledge exchange – available from all EU MS



WHAT CAN TAIEX DO?

- Policy dialogue
- Sector maturity or introduction of new sector ideas
- Stakeholder coordination
- Give input to Programming
- Contribute to budget support





TAIEX INTPA: Application Process



How to apply for TAIEX assistance? Application form

- Objective what do you want to achieve with this TAIEX event?
- Target audience who in your administration will benefit?
- Main topics / content what do you suggest to be discussed, agenda points?
- Current situation what is the situation in your administration? how is your department/institution organised? what are the challenges in your administration? what is in place (policies, laws, strategies, action plans...)?
- **Justification** why do you want TAIEX to support? Is there any other ongoing assistance? Have you considered any other funding options? Why now?



TALD FACILITY in practice:

- Covers X days of Technical Assistance by international or local senior and junior experts
- Pays for travel expenses of experts (economy airfare and official per-diems)
- ➤ In exceptional cases, can support and co-fund logistical needs (venues, catering, local transport)



Steps to access support from the TALD Facility:

- > EUD sends a preliminary request (email) to INTPA G2
- ➤ G2 schedules a coordination call EUD-G2-TALD to understand the needs
- > If pertinent, TALD Facility shares template TORs
- > EUD drafts TORs, fine-tuning the request
- ➤ G2 approves the TORs
- > TALD Facility proposes experts to EUD
- > EUD and G2 agree on selected expert(s)
- > Experts report directly to EUD
- > EUD comments and approves the expert(s) report(s)
- ➤ G2/TALD Facility verify contractual compliance

Policy Forum on Development (PFD)

Established **2013** by EC

Aim: improving the effectiveness of EU development cooperation PFD members include:

associations of local authorities and civil society organisations at the global and European Union level as well as from the four main EU cooperation areas;

representatives of EU Member States;

EU institutions.

Currently there are consulting processes on EU LAC summit, NDICI Mid-term review, EU SDGs Voluntary review, 10th anniversary of EC Communication

Partnerships for Sustainable Cities

Objective: to promote integrated urban development by fostering peer-to-peer exchanges among Local Authorities of EU Member States and partner countries around shared challenges

- Launched in 2018
- > **164,7M** Euro (under previous MFF 2018-2020)
- Three calls for proposals (2019, 2020, 2021)
- > **57** city-to-city partnerships
- > 130 local government partners in 34 countries
- ➤ **Green deal:** resilience, mobility, waste management, water and sanitation, urban planning, climate mitigation and adaptation, energy transition, circular economy and public space.
- ➤ In **APAC:** Indonesia, Tajikistan, Timor Leste and Mongolia
