

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History



Timor-Leste – fragile state

Key indicators:

- ❑ Lower-middle-income country;
- ❑ Ranked **134th** out of 187 countries by HDI (2013);
- ❑ Placed 33 by the PCI (2012);
- ❑ **Other challenges:** 2004 and 2006 crises, extreme poverty, weak public and private sector capacity, poor infrastructure, limited capacity, unemployment, lack of access to water resources etc.
- ❑ **Timor-Leste:** chair of g7+(Dili,2010), endorsed New Deal (Busan, 2011), pilot for ND implementation, Emilia Pires is a member of the HLP for post-2015 agenda;

Timor-Leste – pilot for the New Deal

Milestones:

- ❑ **Timor-Leste carried out a Fragility Assessment (2012);**
- ❑ **Set up of a New Deal Implementation Task Force (2013);**
- ❑ **Plans to conduct a TRUST Assessment in 2013;**
- ❑ **Transition Compact?**
- ❑ **Australia – leading partner for the ND implementation in TL;**
- ❑ **EU – expressed commitment to become a partner for the ND implementation in TL;**

 - **Sector 1:** *Governance and Support to Civil Society → PSG 1+PSG 5;*
 - **Sector 2:** *Technical and Vocational Education Training (TVET) → PSG 4+PSG 5;*
- ❑ *To assess the major causes and drivers of fragility and resilience in Timor-Leste;*
- ❑ *"Take context as the starting point" (OECD FPS);*
- ❑ *Improving aid effectiveness and achieving better results.*
