


The European Investment Bank (EIB)

- European Union's long-term lending bank set up in 1958 by the Treaty of Rome
- European Investment Fund (part of the EIB Group)
- Shareholders: 28 EU Member States

2013 marks the 50th anniversary of the EIB activities in the ACP countries

Development of infrastructure



Water & sanitation

The EIB has invested nearly EUR 450m in water & sanitation projects in the ACPs and OCTs since 2003

The UN has declared 2013 the International Year of Water



- According to UN, more than one in six of the world's population does not have access to clean drinking water, and two and a half billion people live without even basic sanitation
- EIB works closely with the European Commission, financial partners, local authorities and NGOs, to supports projects that contribute to achieving the Millennium Development Goals on water and sanitation
