

Training: Disability Mainstreaming 17-21 March 2014



Disability mainstreaming

- Do people with disabilities have equal access to the projects of your organisation?
- How to make sure that disability inclusion is not a one time activity in a project?

In this training course you will learn which practical steps can be taken to include people with disabilities in your projects and how your organisation can meet up with the new requirements of institutional donors regarding inclusion of people with disabilities.

The training course 'Disability Mainstreaming' is the result of a cooperation between **MDF Training & Consultancy** and **Light for the World**. It is a 5-day course divided in two modules:

1. Disability Mainstreaming in projects (3 days)
2. Disability Mainstreaming in organisations (2 days).

Meaning that you can either follow the course as a whole or in separate parts.

1. identify and address barriers that exclude disabled people;
2. enhance participation of persons with disabilities;
3. write disability inclusive project proposals.

MODULE 2 (20-21 March 2014) DISABILITY MAINSTREAMING IN ORGANISATIONS

After this module you are able to:

1. analyse your own organisation on disability inclusiveness;
2. identify different steps of organisational change to anchor disability into an organisation.
3. start concrete activities to mainstream disability in your organisation.
