A1.1	Strengthen high level Climate policy dialogue through UNEP's close relations with Ministers of Environment and as Secretariat of the Forum of Ministers
	Specific actions for Activity 1.1
1.1.1	Preparatory technical meeting and high level dialogue on Climate Change policy before and during the XIX Forum of Ministers of Environment of Latin America and the Caribbean, from 10 to 14 March 2014.
1.1.2	Climate Change dialogues/side events during regional and sub-regional meetings taking place in 2014 and 2015, including, meetings of ministers of environment and, to the extent possible, meetings of Ministers of Economy, Planning and Energy.

MAIN ACTIVITY 1.2

A1.2	Enhance understanding of major climate change policy issues of relevance to the negotiation processes in the region.

1.2.1	Two regional workshops of climate change negotiators in conjunction with UNFCCC Secretariat to be held in 2014 and 2015.
1.2.2	Develop and moderate an ongoing interactive web-based Community of Practice on climate policy dialogue.
1.2.3	Identify and produce three technical studies on key issues.

A1.3	Execute a policy analysis of the state of play and policy options within the region for key issues addressed in activity 1.1.1, in advance of COP 20 and 21.

1.3.1	Develop and disseminate 3 policy analysis on key issues addressed during the EUROCLIMA Focal Points in activity 1.1.1.

EXPECTED RESULT 2

R2	National climate change debate and legislation in the national parliaments and Parlantino has been promoted.
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MAIN ACTIVITY 2.1

A2.1	Give guidance on National Legislation for Climate Change for the LAC region to include all key elements to combat climate change at the national level, in collaboration with the PARLATINO.

Expected Result 3:	
R3	The role of civil society and public awareness about climate change, in particular in the context of the preparation of the COP20, have been strengthened.
Main Activity 3.1:	
A3.1	Increase capacity and understanding among opinion leaders from the media in the LAC region through participation and orientation at COP20, development and dissemination of training and outreach material, and an online course for journalists.
	Specific activities towards A3.1:
3.1.1	Online course for journalists of the LAC region of relevance to COP20, in coordination with the government of Peru, UNFCCC Secretariat, and others.
3.1.2	Participation and an orientation meeting of journalists of the LAC region on key issues, in coordination with the government of Peru, UNFCCC Secretariat and others.
Main Activity 3.2:	
A3.2	Promote discussion and knowledge sharing through a web platform on climate change case law and jurisprudence, legal violations, active legal cases, best practices, needs and challenges for access to justice, including how to gain access to legal representation.
