
# New Priorities

- **Security and Climate Change**
- **Counter Terrorism – Country Specific (400% budget increase)**
- **Increased focus on Cyber Security**

# SHIFT 2014-2020

- **Increased focus on threats to law and order, security and safety of individuals, critical infrastructure and public health (2/3)**
- **And less on CBRN Risk Mitigation (1/3)**

# IcSP Article 5 (2014-2020) EUR 478 million ~ 70M/year

# Wider Indian Ocean – CRIMARIO


**CRIMARIO** launched in 2014,  
funded with EUR 5.5 million.

## **Aims:**

- Enhance information sharing between countries in the Western Indian Ocean and South East Asia.
- Build capacity to increase trans-regional cooperation on maritime safety and countering piracy.

## **Geographical Scope**

India, Kenya, Singapore, South Africa, Tanzania, Yemen (tbc)



# Cyber Security

*2013: Launch of a EUR 1.5 million project in South-Eastern Europe and the Western Balkans.*

- **Increase the security and resilience of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) networks in targeted countries;**
- **Build local capacities to adequately prevent, respond to (and prosecute) cyber-attacks and/or accidental failures and;**
- **Establish an appropriate legal framework at regional level.**

*2016: EUR 11 million - to be developed.*

# Aviation Security

*AAP2014 – EUR 7 million*

- **CT focus: Africa**
- **Assistance shall primarily contribute to building the necessary national and regional capacities at the operational, supervisory and regulatory levels to help third countries meet ICAO aviation security standards and recommended practices (SARPs). (Congo)**



# The CoE Initiative: a worldwide regional-based CBRN network

## *Structure:*

- **Regional Secretariats (Rabat, Amman, Tbilissi, Manilla inaugurated in 2013+ Nairobi, Algiers, Tashkent and Gulf Coop. Council under discussion)**
- **46 partner countries (+25 candidates)**
- **CBRN National Focal Points and their CBRN National Teams (all relevant ministries represented)**

## *Funded activities:*

- **Technical regional Round Tables**
- **Meetings (global, regional, national levels)**
- **Needs Assessments and National Action Plan**
- **Projects**

## Tools: Regional Projects

- **40 IfS funded projects signed**
  - Consulting, training, capacity building, some equipment, no research
- **Project priorities & specification defined during Round Tables**
- **Regional focus, duration up to 4 years, significant budget**
- **Regional ownership (evaluation of offers, negotiation, implementation and monitoring, coordination of activities)**
- **EU MS consortia in the lead, PC invited to join consortia**

# **Tools: Needs Assessment Questionnaire (NAQ)**

- **Developed by the EU (EC), recently tested in 3 partner countries: Moldova, Armenia and Lebanon**
- **Voluntary, confidential (data belongs to partner countries)**
- **User friendly, modular, paper or electronic**
  - YES/ NO/ DON'T KNOW/ INFO
- **Make use of existing data sets (National/ International)**
- **Basis to prepare National Action Plans**

# Tools : NATIONAL ACTION PLANS

- **Based on NAQs**
- **Template under development**
- **Voluntary, confidential (data belongs to partner countries), EU support if required**
- **Priority countries**

# Way forward

- **Consolidate the CoE structure**
- **Consolidate the role of CBRN NPFs and their National Teams**
- **NAQs completion**
- **NAPs development and implementation**
- **Full coordination with other National and International CBRN activities**
- **Extend coverage**
