



(Quantitative + Qualitative)



Step Two

Conflict prevention priority countries

Monitoring EU Preventive Actions




Step Three


CHECKLIST FOR STRUCTURAL RISKS OF CONFLICT

What is the Checklist?

Risk assessment carried out by EU staff in-country, including EEAS, Commission, CSDP Missions, EUSRs, EU Member States in-country

Questionnaire covering 10 risk areas associated with structural, long-term risks of violent conflict within a country

Opportunity for EU staff in the field to assess & communicate risks and develop options for preventive action




In line with your assessment of each risk area, please note where you see the potential for additional actions or adjustments to current engagement to address these structural risks or to capitalise on positive trends AND where there are ongoing efforts. RISK Area 1: Legitimacy PROPOSED 'options for EU action' to address identified risks or opportunities for this risk area. ONGOING prevention, peacebuilding or security-related efforts for this risk area.



MONITORING EU PREVENTIVE RESPONSES

Country Conflict Prevention Report

- Summary assessment, analysis and monitoring in a single tool
- Concretely links EU prevention responses to the country analysis
- Stimulates more coherent and comprehensive thinking on potential EU responses
- An 'at a glance' report for policy and programme decision-makers
