



Fourth Call for Proposals: The Energy and Environment Partnership Programme with Southern and East Africa (EEP-S&EA)

The Energy and Environment Partnership Programme with Southern and Eastern Africa (EEP-S&EA or EEP, for short) seeks good quality and innovative project proposals concerning renewable energy and/or energy efficiency for grant part-financing. EEP is jointly funded by the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland, the Austrian Development Agency and the UK Department for International Development (DFID) while the EEP Regional Coordination Office (RCO) is hosted by the Development Bank of Southern Africa (DBSA) in Midrand, Johannesburg, South Africa.

Please note that due to a DBSA Management decision to restrict all access to the building and further halt all active ICT office support during the 2011 December Holidays, the CFP4 online submissions will only be enabled on the 4th of January 2012 after normal ICT support has been restored. A worksheet of the online application form is attached for your perusal and as an aid to assist you to prepare filling in the online application form which will be made accessible on the website (www.eepafrica.org) from the 4th – 16th January 2012. To save you time, you are kindly advised to print the worksheet and prepare all that is required before proceeding to fill up the form online. It is also very important to familiarize yourself with all the changes in the application requirements by reading the Call for Proposals Application Guidelines document first before proceeding to complete the form online. Proposals can be submitted to the EEP Regional Coordination Office ONLY through the EEP website once the online system is opened, therefore emailed submissions will not be accepted and are strongly discouraged.

The maximum grant allocated to a project will be €200 000 and all applicants are required to provide some level of own contribution. Please check the Guidelines for more details on this.

To be eligible, your proposal should be implemented in one or more of the partner countries which are Botswana, Kenya, Mozambique, Namibia, Seychelles, South Africa, Swaziland, Tanzania and Zambia. Regional proposals involving two or three partner countries are also welcomed.
