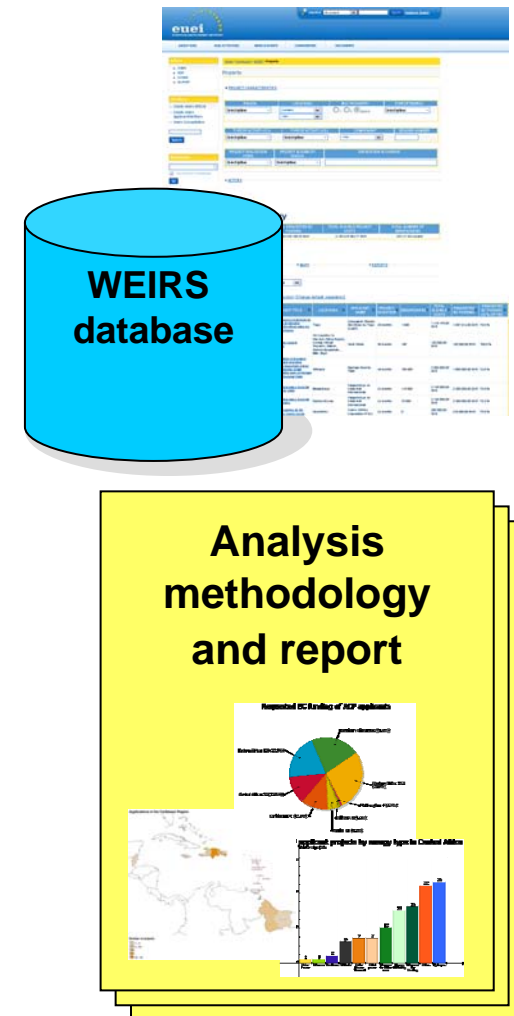
WF: Sustainable access to safe drinking water and basic sanitation & improved water governance and sustainable management of water resources and infrastructures

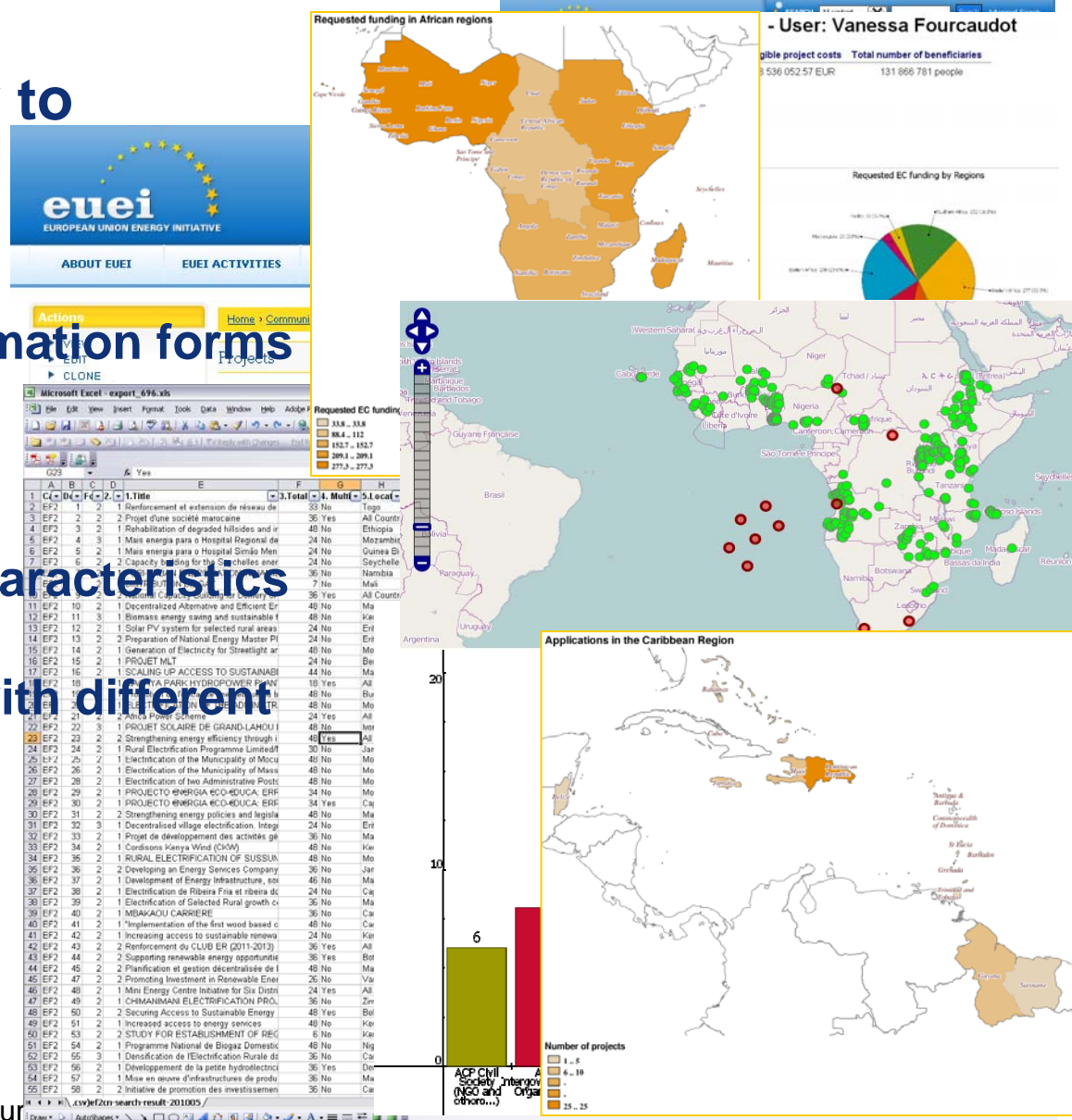





CALL FOR PROPOSALS – OUTSTANDING PARTICIPATION!

667 proposals for a total requested amount of €1 billion have been submitted to the Call for Proposals launched on 30 November 2009.

The administrative check of Concept Notes has been finalised on 22 March. 54 proposals have been rejected on different grounds: concept notes submitted after the deadline, amount requested too high or too small, countries or applicants not eligible... 613 proposals have been accepted and are now being evaluated. The evaluation of Concept Notes is expected to end by the end of April 2010.

In this release you will find a first analysis of the proposals submitted to this Call.

First analysis of the proposals submitted to the Call

1. Large participation

If one compares both the number of proposals received and the total amount requested to the Energy Facility with the figures for the Call launched under the 1st Energy Facility in 2006, one can see a significant increase in this Call:


	EF 1 (2006)	EF 2 (2009)
Number of proposals received	307	667
CN evaluated	230	613
Grants requested	€ 565 million	€ 978 million
Total cost of projects	€ 1330 million	€ 2213 million

This steep increase in participation reveals increased interest and expertise in the area of access to energy and the development of renewable energy sources. It is also probably linked to a better knowledge on the Energy Facility.
