





- ◆ Work Programme for EUWI-EECCA Component approved in March 2005
- ◆ Country specific background papers exist

- ◆ Monitoring and reporting mechanism under preparation



Future steps

- ◆ Launch, at least, two National Policy Dialogues in 2006 – one regarding WSS and Financing, one regarding IW RM
- ◆ Enlarging the scope of IW RM to include national legal and regulatory framework
- ◆ Transfer of ownership to the EECCA countries
- ◆ Identify lead EU Member State or international organisation to act as Chair
