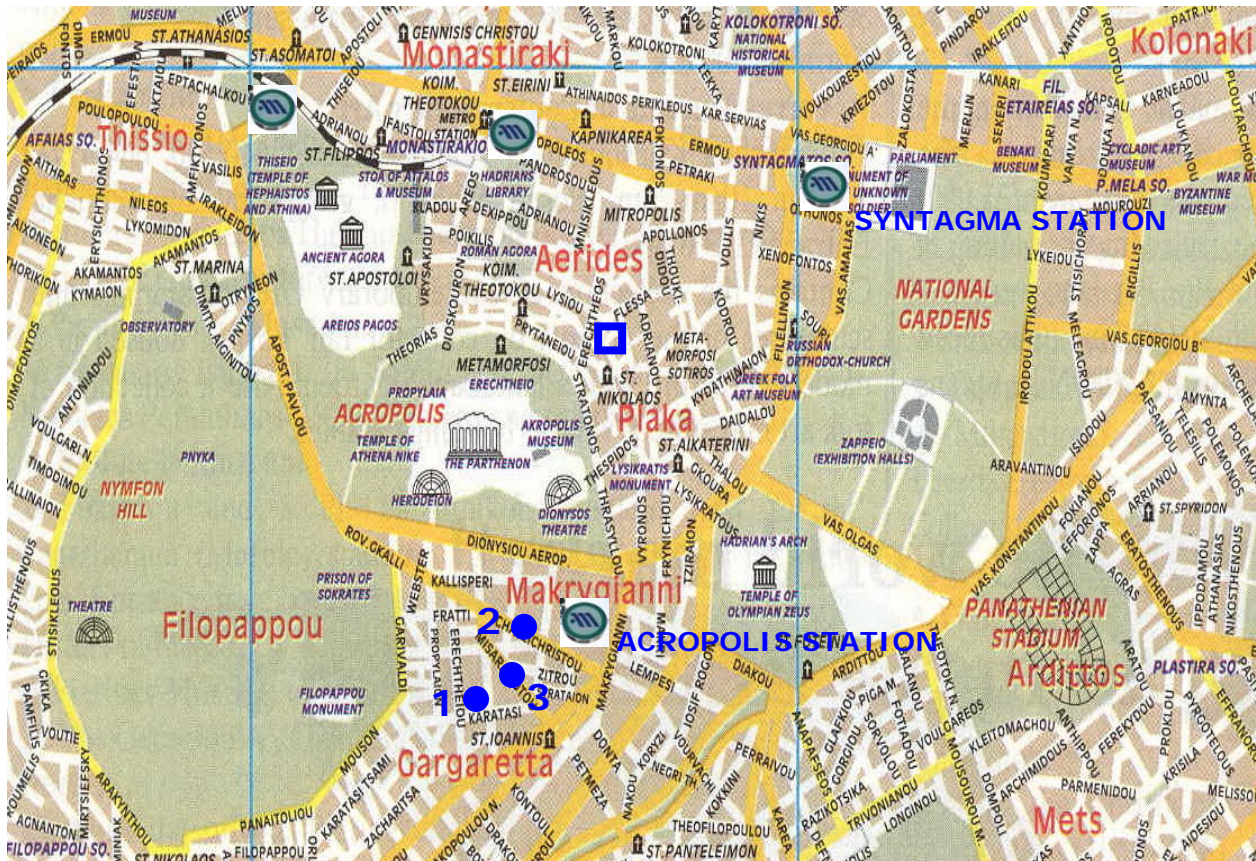

Orientation - Transportation

Participants are kindly requested to arrange for their own transfers between the Athens' airport "Eleftherios Venizelos" and the hotel or the meeting venue. Please note that local transportation will not be reimbursed.

How to get to your Hotel:

1. From the Airport you can use the **Suburban metro** (Line 3: Blue Line) from the airport to "SYNTAGMA" station and then change to Line 2 (Red Line - Direction Aghios Dimitrios) to the "ACROPOLIS" station and walk from the station to the hotel (about 5 min). There are departures to and from the airport every 30 minutes. The ticket costs 6 Euros and it takes about 40-50 minutes to reach the ACROPOLIS station.

2. You can also take the **Airport shuttle bus** (No. E95 - 24 hours service), which goes to "SYNTAGMA" square. The ticket costs 3,20 Euros and, depending on the traffic, the journey takes 40-60 minutes. From there you can either walk (less than 15 min.) or use the **Suburban metro** (Line 2: Red Line) from "SYNTAGMA" station to "ACROPOLIS" station (Direction Aghios Dimitrios) or directly take a taxi to the hotel.

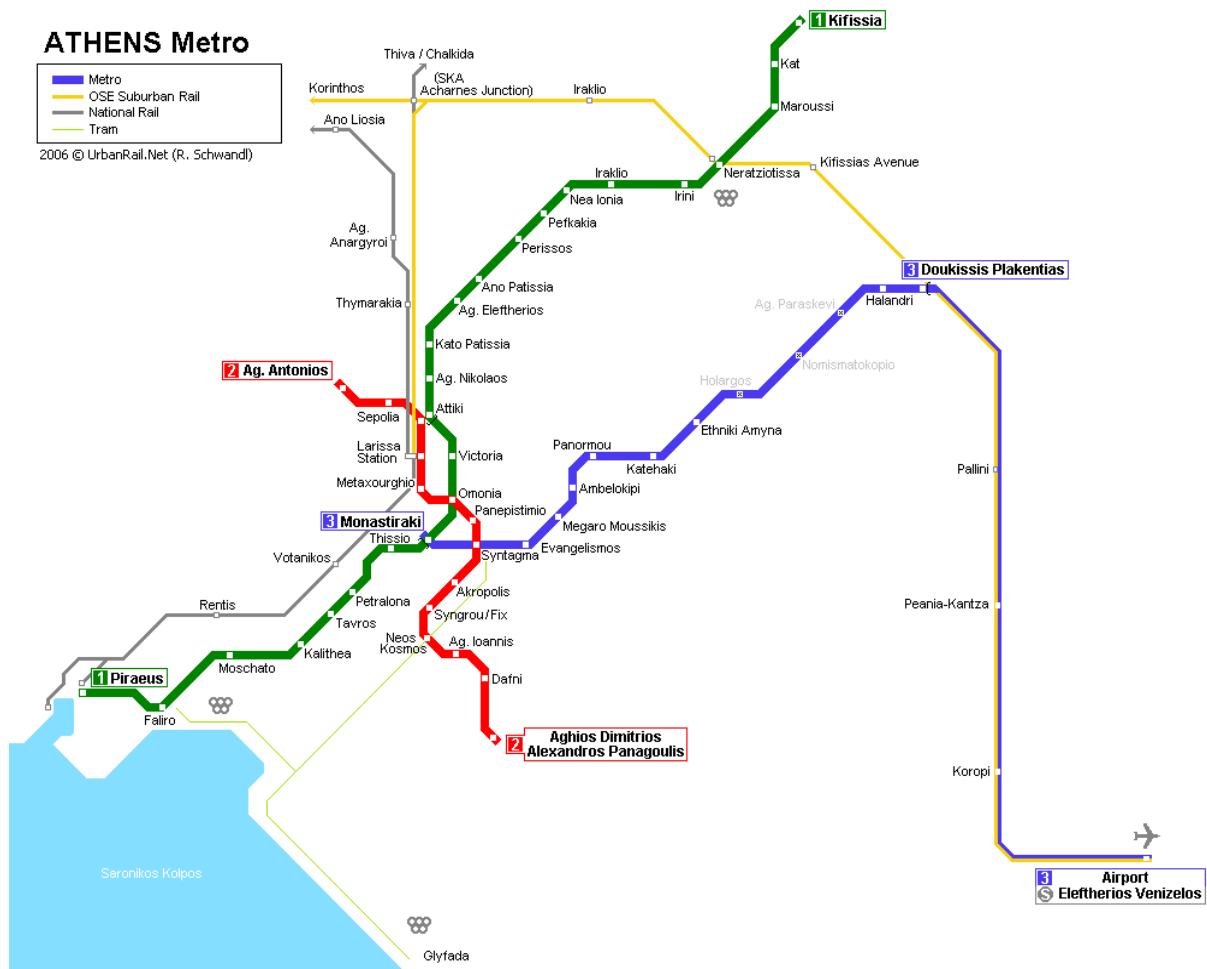
3. You can take a **taxi** from the Airport (cost: 20-30 Euros)

How to reach the meeting venue:

1. You can use the **Suburban metro** (Line 3: Blue Line) from the airport to "SYNTAGMA" station and then walk to the venue (less than 10 min.). There are departures to and from the airport every 30 minutes. The ticket costs 6 Euros and it takes about 40 minutes to Syntagma Square.

2. From the Airport you can also take the **Airport shuttle bus** (No. E95 - 24 hours service), which goes to "SYNTAGMA" square. The ticket costs 3,20 Euros and, depending on the traffic, the journey to Syntagma takes 40-60 minutes. From there you can walk to the venue (approximately 10 min).

3. You can take a **taxi** from the Airport (cost: 20-30 Euros)

In all cases, please check with the Greek Embassy in your country.
