Strengthen EU coordination on D4D (D4D Hub Africa Branch):

- Exchange information on projects (D4D Hub label)
- Identify TEIs with a thematic and/or geographic scope
- Supporting the EU-AU dialogue on digital, joint engagement
- Localize the global D4D Hub strategy
- Promote dialogue with EU and African private sector actors, academia and think tanks
- Thematic working groups

Engage in Africa-Europe strategic dialogue:

TRANSFORMATIONAL POTENTIAL

Support the digital transformation in Africa by fostering multi-stakeholder dialogue, joint partnerships, and investments in the digital domain

KEY DELIVERABLES

1. Under exploration:

- Extension of the Medusa cable from the Mediterranean to the Atlantic along the West and Central Africa coast, in complementarity with CEF.
- Extension of EllaLink (BELL) to Mauritania, in complementarity with CEF.
- Further extension of EllaLink to Canary Islands.
- Financing of the planned Amilcar Cabral submarine cable, connecting Cabo Verde to Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Liberia, Sierra Leone and the Gambia.

2. Secure EurAfrica Gateway Cable: Data centre for EO and STI, pooling resources with NOSi and OSCM in Mindelo (Cape Verde), for Oceanography and Blue Economy.

3. CAR fibre optic cable: 834/900 Km optic fiber cables installed, Network Operation Center built and equipped (97%) - 4365 jobs created (mostly temporary). Digital Training Centre, including an incubator for digital enterprises within the University of Bangui (Huawei supplies equipment to training center).

4. DRC Fibre Optic Backbone project: signed! Delivery of high speed broadband in 9 towns and deployed along the railways (1,280 km long) and on poles along the road (139 km).

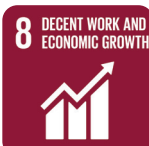
