TEAM EUROPE PROPOSAL

Promote the international outreach of EU Digital Single Market (technologies, regulation, and standards) with special emphasis on global convergence

Contribute to the effective implementation of the EU-Mercosur Association Agreement exploring the potential of digitisation in commerce and trade facilitation

Actions to be undertaken:

- Partnerships
 - EU Brazil multiannual partnerships involving stakeholders (public bodies, companies, universities)
 - Organisation of yearly events on public policies and regulatory key aspects of digital market.

- A yearly public showcase of the EU Brazil cooperation on digital economy

- Business-to-business partnerships between EU and Brazilian digital companies

KEY DELIVERABLES

Digital connectivity

ELLA-link, 35,000 km of cables connecting the EU (from Portugal) and the Latin American region (through Brazil) by means of an optic cable. It is the first connection of this kind between two continents. The ambition is to bridge the digital divide with and within Latin America and enhance international data exchange that catalyses cooperation on research, innovation, education, in parallel to the deployment of 5G infrastructure. The EU mobilised investments from several financial institutions in the order of EUR 26.5 million in a Team Europe spirit, including the EIB's Marguerite Fund. Brazil contributed with EUR 15 million.
