## How can the UDTF help you?

If your Actions aim at achieving sustainable urban development, occur in urban contexts, or intervene at the local level for urban populations, the **Urban Development Technical Facility (UDTF)**, in the framework of DG INTPA's Green Deal Knowledge Hub, is now open to provide assistance to EU Delegations.

The UDTF can provide advice and support from the identification and formulation of projects, to assisting with the implementation of an Action. It offers expert advice (remote and/or in situ), conducts pre-feasibility studies, executes diagnostics, offers short-term support for decision-making processes, supports policy dialogue, and much more.

## How to use the UDTF?

The Facility is **demand-driven**, adapted for specialized, short-term **technical assistance** in virtually all fields of sustainable urban development. This includes, but is not limited to:
