KEY DELIVERABLES

Development of digital and innovative solutions that provide access to social protection coverage and basic labour rights, capacity and productive development focused on informal and independent workers.

TVET

 Implementation of a vocational training system with the private sector in at least 10 vocational training facilities tackling vulnerable youth as well as 1,000 independent or informal workers who benefit from digital social protection solutions.

NATIONAL CONTEXT

28.3% of the population are youth under 30:

- 14.4% unemployment rate for youth at employment age (more than twice the country's average)
- 24.8% neither studies nor works
- 79.9% of these are young women

Approx. 68 000 formal jobs could be lost due to COVID-19 (ILO, 2020):

• One third corresponds to young people (15 to 29 years)

Limited coverage of social digital infrastructure:

- One of the lowest mobile broadband penetrations (43%) in Latin America (65%)
- More than half of the population continues to be disconnected
- More than 90% of those connected are with prepaid plans (limited access)

Low level of digital skills and gender gap:

- 92nd out of 129 countries Global Innovation Index (GII)
- 131st out of 141 countries on active population's digital skills - (WEF* Global Competitiveness Index)
- 80th out of 153 positions on gender parity, with low education and skills indicators (Global Gender Gap Index)

Limited institutional capacity to increase digitalization:

132nd of 141 countries in institutional weakness (WEF)

124th place on adaptability of legal framework to digital business models (WEF)

Low level of human capital in digital solutions and infrastructure - 107 out of 129 countries (GII)
