Threats

Deficient land management and deforestation

- Linked to expansion of agricultural production, illegal trade
- Causes degradation of water resources, loss of biodiversity and decrease of productivity

Environmental risks' vulnerability (hurricanes, droughts and floods)

• Food insecurity and malnutrition

SUSTAINABLE CITIE AND COMMUNITIES

Driver of migration

Embryonal inter-institutional coordination around climate change

Natural resources' management characterized by corruption, lack of law enforcement, criminality and HR's violations

Conflicts over land tenure and property rights for the use of natural resources\COVID-19 exacerbated poverty, food insecurity, migration, underemployment, violence and social tensions

- Fights against climate change

- Restoration of 1 million hectares of forests.
- Reduction by 15% of GHG emissions
- Reduction of firewood consumption by 35%
