Visa free regime (2017)

 mobility and people-topeople contacts (EU and GE).

Before COVID-19 pandemic - 5 % average annual GDP growth.

Challenges linked to its democratic consolidation and political polarisation:

- Parliamentary elections (2020).
- Local elections (October 2021).
- Governing party withdrawal (April 2021).

Deep recession in 2020:

 lockdowns led to a contraction of ca.
6.2% of GDP.

Strong recovery (April – September 2021) - additional tax revenues. MIP 2021-2027 – 5 priorities:

- Resilient, sustainable and integrated economy,
- Accountable institutions,
- Rule of law and security,
- Environmental and climate resilience,
- Resilient digital transformation,
- Resilient, fair & inclusive society.
