NATIONAL CONTEXT Deforestation (20% - 25%) and forest Amazon forest (Amazon River basin and the Guiana shield): degradation: populations of species • 58% of the world tropical forest • Emitted more GHG than it has absorbed over the last decade 20% of world freshwater reserves

- More than 20% of the total world biodiversity
- Caused by agricultural expansion, infrastructure development, legal and illegal exploitation
- High variability of the Amazon Basin countries affect

Loss of biodiversity: reduction and/or extinction of entire

1.5 million people have recognised land rights over at least 25% of the forest
