Renewable energy

Modernize the transmission and distribution grid of Cambodia to improve the network reliability and efficiency, lowering the high electricity costs, which have a high impact in the competitiveness of the country. The project will facilitate the integration of large-scale renewable energy to the grid, by:

- a) Upscaling of the transmission and distribution management systems of EDC (Electircite du Cambodge).
- b) Support to the digital change and preparation of EDC teams to the management of change and the introduction of modern IT Services Management.
- c) Design and setting up of a Research and Training Platform, and the Development of a Master Programme in Power Systems Management.

NATIONAL CONTEXT

Significant development progress:

- Strong economic growth: 7.7% from 1995 to 2018
- Lower-middle income status (since 2015, WBI)
- Green growth and job creation are a priority

Garment sector:

- 11% of GDP in 2018

- Employing 21% of paid former workers or almost 1 million people, mainly women
