Priority countries - which criteria?



The country is listed or close to being listed by the EU and/or the FATF as a high-risk country.

The request is inline with EU bilateral strategic dialogues and priorities.

There is no duplication with EU existing technical assistance





- Degree of country's commitment/ willingness to engage
 - Existing buy-in
- High likelihood of local ownership

STAGES OF THE FINANCIAL INVESTIGATION AND PENAL CHAIN





Some achievements

The EU Global Facility is a vehicle for innovation through pilot projects and leading-edge thematic activities. e.g.: Metaverse, FATF statistics, FATF Standards training..

South-South cooperation is a success through cross-fertilisation.

Experts from Morocco, Mauritius, Panama trained by EU GF now deliver technical assistance

Established as a reference with tangible results. e.g.: 7 partner countries delisted since 2020

Lessons learned

Interventions based on request from a third country to receive technical assistance is an effective entry point, and offers some guarantees of commitment from local stakeholders.

FATF evaluations and reports are excellent baseline to engage with a country.

The comprehensive approach to AML/CFT is relevant, in particular by bringing together people involved in AML/CFT who are normally not used to discussing.
