HOW DO MEMBERS OF THE FORUM ACT?




They represent the Latin American municipalities of the GCoM in regional and international climate agenda events.




They strengthen the visibility of local climate action in their countries and in Latin America through campaigns, meetings, and exchanges between cities, as well as through presence in various media outlets.
