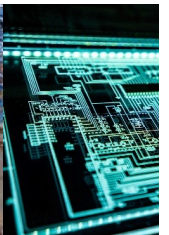

Pillar I: Reducing the digital gap

5 projects

€ 145 million

- Underserved populations get better access to digital services
- Private sector, governance structures and social services benefit from improved digital infrastructure

The **EU**, the **Netherlands** and **Belgium** invest in

- Last mile digital connectivity in underserved areas (i.e. primary schools)
- Connectivity of county government buildings
- Enhancement of digital infrastructure with the support of Data Centres
- Investment to expand the coverage and capacity of the mobile telecommunications network (3G and 4G) as well as the Fibre To The Building network to provide fixed broadband services to SMEs and corporate customers
