
### EEOs on the rise






## Overall assessment








## Use of suspected non-eligible measures



#### Eligibility of Measures and Additionality of Savings


Reported savings per measures as share of minimum target (based on Eurostat data 2010-12)

## Multiple benefits





**Jobs.** 13 to 17 jobs (new or maintained) per €1 million investment in energy efficiency measures.



**Deployable and high leverage investments.** Existing demand makes the projects quickly deployable. In addition, €1 of public investment in energy efficiency measures can trigger private investment of €13-20 per capita.



**Security.** Reduction of gas imports by 2.6% for 1% of energy saved.


