Three years – April 2013 – March 2016



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Aims of project:

- Improve awareness of students understanding of local and global issues
- Develop students' confidence as global citizens
- Teachers to work as Professional Learning Communities
- Work with teachers to develop their confidence to use local and global development in their everyday teaching
- Ability of teachers to dispel stereotypes and prejudices of other cultures
- Involve the local community and increase schools' capacity to work with local community.



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Outputs of project:

For pupils

- skills development (EU competences and IN NPT reflect our LNF and wider skills frameworks)
- Greater confidence in critical analysis of local development issues and global issues

For Teachers

- Professional toolkit of resources and embedding these themes into more areas of the curriculum

Local Communities

- Increase in links between schools and local communities



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Challenges to running a DEAR funded project at LA level:
