









PARTICULARITIES OF THE STUDY:












- Revitalisation of sectoral spaces at local level.



VALIDATION PROCESS:







- A tailored based approach
 A tool to respond to sectoral needs
 Rapid mobilisation of the necessary expertise
- A way to translate recommendations into action
- Designed to incorporate EUMS knowledge and experience (ACODEA/COLEAD/SOLIDARIDAD)







RECOMMENDATIONS- CHEESE VC IN CAQUETA

- Adoption of agroecological practices
- ❖ Ensure increased coverage and quality of technical assistance for milk processing.
- **Exchanges** between actors, a catalyst for innovation.
- *Raise and improve associativity and articulation between actors, to strengthen their trade negotiation capacity and achieve greater transparency.
- Improve the inclusiveness of the chain by overcoming conflicts between existing trade organisations.
- **❖** Rethink the initiative around the Designation of Origin and the QC Mark.
- Support the transition of existing groups with favourable organisational, social capital and equipment conditions towards an industrial scale-up





APPLYING RECOMMENDATIONS

- **❖** From a Brand QC led intervention, to the "Milk Network"
- **❖** Governance assessment and tailored led solutions (ACODEA)
- ❖ Transition to more sophisticated markets, Truvalu and BDS interventions
- ❖ Increased outreach of service delivery through an unified rural extension guide, on sustainable livestock farming





RECOMMENDATIONS COCOA VC

- Articulate efforts with Research
 - * Approach higher value markets for specialized cocoa
 - * Regional specialization and differentiation
 - Profitability of the production system
 - Cluster approach
 - Climate change adaptation action (Solidaridad)
 - * Youth inclusion in the value chain





APPLYING RECOMMENDATIONS COCOA VC

- Potential for C sequestration, re think interventions in terms of climate financing (Solidaridad)
- Provide evidence-based data for decision making (on varieties, production methods, increasing productivity...) Cost production Sheets (Acodea)
- Integration of youth into the value chains Digital marketing







APPLYING RECOMMENDATIONS COCOA VC

Encourage a shift towards specialised cocoa, based on the organoleptic profile (Cacao Disidente –
 Chocofest)

Strengthen support and linkages to more specialized markets,
 BDS and Truvalu support









SCALING UP

- Rutas PDET a reference intervention model in action
- ART's commitment to scale-up in the context of the "Integrated Approach"
- Support for 2 out of the 31 integrated policy goals (National Development Plan 2022-2026)
- Continuity of the VCA4D training process in Colombia

VCA4D allowed an integrated approach, sharing information, changing paradigms, highlighting the VC contribution to economic growth in the territories and in Colombia
