The **European Union** in a **joint effort** with its **Member States** implements the **Team Europe Initiative (TEI) on Inclusive and Equitable Societies** to contribute to the **reduction of inequalities** in **Latin America and the Caribbean**. This initiative, which represents an important step in the **2023/2025 EU-CELAC roadmap** towards the next bi-regional Summit, fosters the **social dimension** of the **Global Gateway** in the **region**.

### A bi-regional engagement

This initiative aims to facilitate **access to social rights** and **services**, enhance **inclusive, accountable and transparent institutions**, as well as to foster **social innovation, resilience** and a **just transition**. This is being

done with a particular focus on **women and youth**, through strategic actions in topics such as **gender equality, social rights, social protection, inclusive employment and education**, and **good governance**.

### European Union and Member States contributions

The **Team Europe Initiative on Inclusive and Equitable Societies** is constituted by **France, Germany, Italy, Luxembourg, Spain and Sweden**.

An estimated total  
contribution of  
**€1.1 billion**  
in **ODA Grants**  
from 2021 to 2027

- Approximately another **€1.4 billion** is added from **investments and loans**.
- An estimate of **400 projects** is implemented at regional, sub-regional, and national levels.
- Through its regional programmes and other instruments, the **European Union** contributes with approximately **€268 million**.
