The **European Union** in a **joint effort** with its **Member States** implements the **Team Europe Initiative** (TEI) **on Inclusive and Equitable Societies** to contribute to the **reduction of inequalities** in **Latin America and the Caribbean**. This initiative, which represents an important step in the **2023/2025 EU-CELAC roadmap** towards the next bi-regional Summit, fosters the **social dimension** of the **Global Gateway** in the **region**.

A bi-regional engagement

This initiative aims to facilitate access to social rights and services, enhance inclusive, accountable and transparent institutions, as well as to foster social innovation, resilience and a just transition. This is being done with a particular focus on women and youth, through strategic actions in topics such as gender equality, social rights, social protection, inclusive employment and education, and good governance.

European Union and Member States contributions

The **Team Europe Initiative on Inclusive and Equitable Societies** is constituted by **France**, **Germany**, **Italy**, **Luxembourg**, **Spain** and **Sweden**.

An estimated total contribution of €1.1 billion in ODA Grants

from 2021 to 2027

- Approximately another **€1.4 billion** is added from **investments** and **loans**.
- An estimate of **400 projects** is implemented at regional, subregional, and national levels.
- Through its regional programmes and other instruments, the **European Union** contributes with approximately **€268 million**.
