

## NaturAfrica West Africa

NaturAfrica is an initiative of the European Union designed to support biodiversity conservation, governance and the development of a green economy in sub-Saharan Africa. It funds projects in mixed landscapes of protected areas such as national parks, community forests, wildlife reserves and forest reserves, and the settlements, peripheral zones and ecological corridors in the vicinity.

In West Africa, the regional programme supports projects in transboundary zones. It is managed under a financing agreement between the European Union and the West Africa Economic and Monetary Union (WAEMU), which represents the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS) on matters related to biodiversity and protected area management.

The Regional Coordination unit supports the development and implementation of the programme. It liaises with the WAEMU Commission and the EU Delegation to Burkina Faso to ensure the effective implementation of the programme.
