As one of Mongolia's leading social research institutions, <u>IRIM</u> undertakes evidence-based research and evaluation across various sectors, with democracy, governance, and social inclusion forming the centerpiece of its work. <u>INCITEGov</u> is a policy advocacy and governance organisation in the Philippines promoting integrity, democratic accountability, and citizen participation.

Objective

To strengthen democratic resilience in Mongolia and the Philippines by promoting integrity in the information ecosystem and empowering local communities to counter disinformation through community-based, participatory approaches.

Key Activities

- (1) Mapping the disinformation landscape in Mongolia and the Philippines;
- (2) Conducting community studies on vulnerability and information behavior;
- (3) Co-designing and piloting community-based interventions;
- (4) Organising regional knowledge-sharing and dissemination workshops.

Target Groups / Beneficiaries

Local community leaders and members identified as the most vulnerable to disinformation, particularly those living in rural or marginalised areas; sectoral stakeholders, including CSOs and policymakers.

Expected Outcomes

The project will strengthen community resilience against disinformation, empowering individuals and local groups to respond critically and proactively. It will enhance public awareness and capacity to counter disinformation while safeguarding media freedom and freedom of expression. A knowledge-sharing toolkit will capture lessons learned and good practices to support replication in other contexts.
