



PFD INFORMATION MEETING ON THE NEXT MFF

2nd of December 2025, 14h-15:30h CET

Context

On 16 July, the Commission adopted its proposals for the Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF) 2028-2034. The package included the proposal for Global Europe, the main financing instrument for external action in the next MFF. The Commission's proposal for Global Europe shows a high level of ambition for external action financing: the proposed budget of EUR 200 billion represents a nominal increase by 75% compared to the current MFF. In addition, EUR 100 billion are proposed to be allocated to the reconstruction and pre-accession assistance for Ukraine and will be financed over and above the MFF ceilings.

Global Europe aims at strengthening the EU's position on the world stage, as a strong and reliable partner, advancing the EU's and partner countries' mutual interests, contributing to sustainable development and enhancing the EU's competitiveness and economic security.

On 3 September 2025, the Commission adopted a second package of sectoral proposals, completing the framework for the next long-term EU budget for 2028-2034. This package included the proposal to amend the Decision on the association of the overseas countries and territories with the Union (DOAG) and the proposal for the Instrument for Nuclear Safety Cooperation – Decommissioning.

A public consultation on the next MFF took place in the first half of 2025 and an online consultation with the PFD was organised in April.
