Support to modernization and reform of higher education institutions and systems in the eligible Partner Countries</p> <p>Who can apply for funding? Higher education institutions and association or organisation of higher education institutions, national or international rector, teacher or student organizations, established in a Programme or in an eligible Partner Country can apply on behalf of the consortium</p> <p>Who can get involved? Higher education institutions and any public or private organisation active in the labour market or in the fields of education, training and youth, established in a Programme or in an eligible Partner country</p> <p>Call details: Closes: 10 February 2016 at 12:00 (midday) Brussels time Budget: € 131.47 million</p>	<p>What does it offer? Opportunity to teach and research in the field of European Union studies worldwide</p> <p>Who can apply for funding? Depending on the activity: higher education institutions or other organisations active in the field of European integration studies, associations of professors and researchers specialising in European Union Studies, established in any country of the world; individuals cannot apply directly for a grant</p> <p>Who can get involved? Professors, young researchers, scholars, civil servants, schools, teachers, civil society, policy makers at local, regional and national level, practitioners in European Union affairs</p> <p>Call details: Closes: 25 February 2016 at 12:00 (midday) Brussels time Budget: Budget: € 11.4 million plus € 3.5 million for certain Partner Countries</p>
