

- Only the LEAD IP role can submit the logframe (and current value) to the EC.
- There is no “View only” role.



- Functionally introduced to allow aggregation of results by country on indicator level
- All beneficiary countries, where activities are implemented, need to be encoded
- Remove unknown, replace with relevant countries and click on “**Validate**”
- Once the logframe and countries are approved, new countries can be added, but no previously added country can be removed anymore
- “Global” only to be used when activities are truly not in any country (mostly globally policy)
- **Country disaggregation will be mandatory** for both **predefined** and **customised** indicators





 - **You need to encode the relevant Result levels:**
 - Impact, Outcome, Output
 - **Add additional information**
 - Add in Results statement (not mandatory field). Data in this field is not visible in the overview of the logframe
 - **Add Result Assumptions**
 - Only for outcomes and outputs
 - Select “To be defined” if it is not available in your Agreement

Encoding Results

Quality check



- When encoding Results and saving them without indicators, an error message indicating an “Invalid” Quality Check will appear in Management Mode
- Error list
- Click on “Go to fix” to correct the error

Encoding Results

- Deleting Results via the little blue arrow → Delete Result

- Only works when NO current values are encoded






Intermediate Targets

- Intermediate targets (milestones) are necessary to ensure meaningful **performance scores for quantitative indicators**, visualised as the Effectiveness Score.
- Performance at the indicator level can be assessed by comparing the current value (actual) with the intermediate target (expected) for the same date.
- No intermediate targets are added for impact-level indicators as they are not directly attributable to the implementation.
- Intermediate targets are automatically generated for every June 30 and December 31 date between the baseline and final target dates.
- Defining and encoding customised intermediate targets for outputs and outcomes can be laborious.
- The automatically generated intermediate targets are created and updated whenever “Save as Draft” is pressed in the Manage Logframe mode.



Intermediate Targets – Output level

- For output-level indicators, intermediate targets are generated by using a linear function between the baseline date and value, and the final target date and value.

c. No progress until end (of the intervention): The outcomes are mostly achieved **at the end of the second half of implementation.**

Intermediate Targets – Outcome level

- For outcome-level indicators, which typically progress non-linearly, the outcome profile must be specified, but the profile type can be adjusted later if needed.
- Three non-linear profiles are suggested for automatic intermediate target generation. The outcome profiles are:
 - a. **None of the above:** Intermediate targets will have to be encoded manually.
- When no intermediate target is encoded manually, then the same approach will be taken by the system by default, as for output level indicators, which is a linear one but starting from the baseline date.

Please note that these automatically generated intermediate targets can always be modified later if needed, either collectively by changing the outcome profile selection or individually by changing specific intermediate targets.

- Selected at the beginning for a new logframe and can be changed via the “Outcome Profile Selection” button

Intermediate Targets – Outcome level


Outcome Profile Selection Form ×

A logframe provides data on target achievement that is used for performance measurement. To ensure meaningful performance scores, intermediate targets (milestones) are necessary. For outputs, these are automatically generated, assuming linear progression between baseline and target. However, for outcomes, which usually progress non-linearly, three non-linear profiles are suggested for automatic intermediate target generation. The outcome profile must be specified initially but can be changed later. Additionally, the automatically generated intermediate targets can be revised or removed as required.


