



This sixth UNEP Emissions Gap Report provides a scientific assessment of anticipated impacts of Intended Nationally Determined Contributions (INDCs) on the emissions trajectory. As in the previous reports, it compares the resulting emission levels in 2030 with what science tells us is required to be on track towards the agreed target of a global average temperature increase below 2 °C by 2100. The Report also provides data for the aspirational target of keeping the temperature increase below 1.5°C.
