- Address shrinking spaces for CSOs



- Address power imbalances inherent to these partnerships
- Stronger regulatory mechanisms for private sector and support for SMEs

# Accountability & Monitoring Efforts


- **Institutionalize CSO accountability mechanisms** at local, national & global levels

- Need for govt's to **fulfill long deferred commitments** on ODA
- Need to make **concrete commitments** in the lead-up to adopting the post-2015 agenda
