

# PARIS OUTCOMES: Partnering for Implementation

## NDC support & Analysis

- *Support enabling conditions for delivery of NDCs:*
  - *Policy and legal/ regulatory frameworks*
  - *Legal and institutional support*
  - *Fiscal policy support (eg fiscal incentives for RE; carbon pricing)*
  - *Assessment of financial resources required and access to finance*
  - *Technology support*
- *Conduct analysis – what will it take to meet 1.5 degrees*

## Adaptation

### existing activities

- *GEF funded support for implementation of National Adaptation Plans of Action (NAPAs)*
- *LDCF/SCCF funded global support for advancing the NAP process*
- *Supporting developing countries (Africa, LAC, Asia Pacific) to integrate and implement ecosystem based adaptation into national plans – funding sources: Germany, EC, AF, GCF, LDCF, SCCF*
- *Promoting EBA for food security in Africa*

### to be implemented

- *NAP formulation projects (eg Rwanda and Laos)*
- *NAPA implementation*
- *GCF Readiness projects*

# PARIS OUTCOMES: Partnering for Implementation

## Loss and Damage

- *UNEP- FI's work with the insurance industry*
- *Contribute to Warsaw loss and Damage Mechanism*

## Mitigation

- *Support countries on mitigation readiness and NAMAs*
- *Energy efficiency programmes (lighting, appliances, transport)*
- *Africa Renewable Energy Initiative*
- *Regional climate knowledge networks - REGATTA, SEAN-CC – to help implementation of COP decisions and S-S collaboration. Exploring replication of similar in other sub-regions*

## Climate Finance

- *Continue to support countries to access existing funding – GCF, GEF*
- *Engagement with China S-S cooperation fund*
- *Private-sector and climate finance (eg Portfolio Decarbonisation Initiative)*

# PARIS OUTCOMES: Partnering for Implementation

## Technology development and transfer

### *Existing:*

- *UNEP, in partnership with UNIDO, host of the CTCN*
- *Examples: TA on refrigerant technologies in Namibia and Mauritius, and efficient lighting in the Dominican Republic*

### *Under development*

- *Programme for LDCs and SIDS – support in analysis of NDCs to identify request for TA*
- *Stakeholder Forum – analysis of NDCs at sub regional level, match demand for technologies and link government and private sector*
- *Regional NDE forum – discussions on linkages between the technology and finance mechanism to meet the NDC goals*

# PARIS OUTCOMES: Partnering for Implementation

## Capacity Building for Transparency, Measuring and Reporting

- *Build on the existing UNEP support to countries for their Biennial Update Reports (BURs) and National Communications*
- *Develop methodologies and guidance for new reporting requirements*
- *Support development and field testing of national systems for transparency, measuring and reporting*

Funding support: Germany; Italy; private foundations
